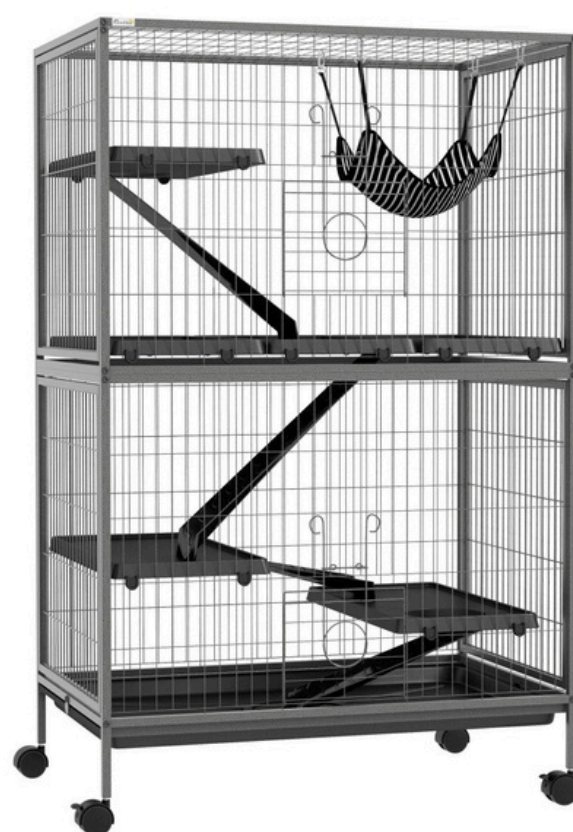

When filling a cage, we suggest hammocks, blankets and cube beds. We also recommend litter trays with wood or paper litter. Puppy pads are another alternative.
